

UK-Pakistan Trade Factsheet

- Total trade in goods and services (exports plus imports) between the UK and Pakistan was £3.0 billion in the four quarters to the end of Q1 2022, an increase of 18.2% or £458 million from the four quarters to the end of Q1 2021.
- In the four quarters to the end of Q1 2022, total UK exports to Pakistan amounted to £1.0 billion (an increase of 25.3% or £210 million compared to the four quarters to the end of Q1 2021).
- Of all UK exports to Pakistan in the four quarters to the end of Q1 2022, £729 million (70.2%) were goods and £310 million (29.8%) were services.
- In the four quarters to the end of Q1 2022, UK exports of goods to Pakistan increased by 30.9% or £172 million compared to the four quarters to the end of Q1 2021 while UK exports of services to Pakistan increased by 14.0% or £38 million compared to the four quarters to the end of Q1 2021.
- In the four quarters to the end of Q1 2022, total UK imports from Pakistan were £1.9 billion (an increase of 14.7% or £248 million compared to the four quarters to the end of Q1 2021).

The top 5 goods exported from the UK to Pakistan in the four quarters to the end of Q1 2022 were:

- 28 Metal ores & scrap (£403.2 million or 55.5% of all UK goods exported to Pakistan)
- 75K Office machinery (capital) (£23.4 million or 3.2%)
- 59 Other chemicals (£21.6 million or 3.0%)
- o 78M Cars (£17.6 million or 2.4%)
- 74K General industrial machinery (capital) (£16.5 million or 2.3%)

The top 5 goods imported to the UK from Pakistan in the four quarters to the end of Q1 2022 were:

- 84 Clothing (£716.5 million or 46.5% of all UK goods imported from Pakistan)
- o 65 Textile fabrics (£488.5 million or 31.7%)
- o 04 Cereals (£88.7 million or 5.8%)
- 05 Vegetables & fruit (£36.5 million or 2.4%)
- 89OC Other manufactures (consumer) (£33.2 million or 2.2%)
